## Before We Arrive...

- Please close all windows and external doors during your treatment.
- All opened or exposed food and related utensils/plates etc. must be covered or in a cupboard. If food is in a container, this is sufficient coverage. Pantry does not require additional coverage unless open food is directly exposed to the air.
- Advise us immediately if anyone at your premises has asthma or any other health issue that in your opinion you should bring to our consideration so we can act in your best interest in terms of treatment or advice.
- If you have pets, remove or cover food and water bowls to protect from potential spray drift.
- If you have dogs/cats/birds/pets move them to an area of the yard or house that won't be affected by spray treatment. We are used to working safely with pets; there are plenty of simple work-arounds just chat with us.
- If you have an aviary please advise us and we will assess how to manage this upon our initial inspection of your property.
- Fish – please advise us upon arrival if you have fish and make sure that tanks are totally covered e.g. with blanket, sheet, tarp etc. while we are actively spraying your premises.
- If premises are being treated for fleas vacuum before we arrive and dispose of vacuum cleaner contents in a sealed container in the outside rubbish bin. We will also ask where your animals like to sleep.
- You do not need to empty any cupboards or drawers.
- Payment is required on the day; you can pay us either with cash, electronic bank transfer or credit card.
- No clothes drying on the line outside.
- We spray a "barrier" along skirting boards. As much as sensibly possible try and move items stored against walls out enough so we can spray the skirting. Don't go crazy and move all furniture etc. Items can remain on the floor – just away from the wall ☺ Phone us if unsure.





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## After Your Treatment

- It is safe for people and animals to use areas we have treated after the spray has dried. Where non-spray methods are used we will advise if any considerations are necessary on your part.
- Where either inside or outside floors have been sprayed leave mopping/hosing and vacuuming as long as you can possibly stand it! (Sweeping is fine) but preferably a minimum of one week. Where your floors have been specifically treated for fleas a minimum of 14 days is ideal. If concerned, vacuuming prior to our arrival can help you wait it out longer! Again don't go crazy, and please just ask if you have any questions in relation to this issue.

## Expectations

- Some treatments work instantly, most will require a small amount of time to do their work. Some treatments may have an initial "instant" result but may take up to a few weeks to have time for the treatment to work through the entire population. If ever you have questions please just chat to me. I'm here to help you.
- Cockroaches – I use only high quality, name brand, thoroughly researched treatments. These treatments have long residual action. Do not be alarmed if you see live bugs after your treatment, what you are looking for is that these bugs are still dying. If so, everything is working perfectly. Remember you are welcome to call and ask questions. I am happy to talk with you.
